## Application Process:

- Only fully documented appeals will be considered; accepts NYRAG Common Application Form. Application form not required. Applicants should submit the following:
  - 1) signature and title of chief executive officer
  - 2) statement of problem project will address
  - 3) population served
  - 4) principal source of support for project in the past
  - 5) copy of IRS Determination Letter
  - 6) brief history of organization and description of its mission
  - 7) copy of most recent annual report/audited financial statement/990
  - 8) how project's results will be evaluated or measured
  - 9) descriptive literature about organization
  - 10) listing of board of directors, trustees, officers and other key people and their affiliations
  - 11) detailed description of project and amount of funding requested
  - 12) copy of current year's organizational budget and/or project budget
  - 13) additional materials/documentation
 Foundation requires determination letters for 509(a) or 501(c)(3) status.
